GUESTS OF MANDARIN ORIENTAL, NEW York, located at Columbus Circle and 60th Street, can experience the ultimate Manhattan retreat in the hotel's Presidential and Oriental Suites, both of which have recently been outfitted with new entertainment technology worth \$100,000. The suites' upgraded audio, video, and gaming experience includes Bang & Olufsen 65-inch plasma and 40-inch LCD televisions, an eight-speaker surround sound system, Blu-ray high-definition DVD players, and an Xbox 360 gaming console, as well as electronically controlled light and temperature systems.

Located on the 53rd floor and measuring 2,230 square feet – or 2,640 square feet with a second bedroom – the Presidential Suite at Mandarin Oriental, New York, offers guests panoramic views of Central Park, the Hudson River, and Midtown Manhattan. Other notable features of the suite include a Steinway baby grand piano; silk wall finishes; and golden onyx, chocolate-veined French marble, and Italian mosaic tiles. The suite also boasts a collection of Asian artifacts and artwork including antique textiles, paintings, and carved figures, as well as a 250-year-old parchment calligraphy book, featuring Chinese characters conveying a story of happiness and good fortune.
