The Falling Rock Balcony Suite features a king- or two queen-sized beds, a large bathroom, a living room, a gas fireplace, and a spacious balcony, overlooking the Mystic Rock golf course and the surrounding mountains. Upon arrival, guests are greeted by a personal butler, who attends to their every whim. For those on a romantic getaway, the butler can draw a candlelit bath or set a private dinner for two on the balcony.

The property's two Champion Suites feature one king- or two queen-sized beds, outfitted with 1,200-thread-count Egyptian cotton sheets, hand-sewn chenille duvet covers, and a choice of 10 pillows; a sleeper sofa in the living room; two flat-screen televisions – one in the bedroom and the other in the living room – and a Bose stereo system; a gas fireplace; a wet bar; and one and a half bathrooms. Guests can enjoy a private, butler-served sunset dinner on the suites' balconies, which overlook Mystic Rock's 18th green. A butler can also draw guests a bath in a 210-gallon soaking tub, as well as decorate the bathroom with flower petals and candles.
