Kosta Browne Winery



KOSTA BROWNE WINERY (www.kostabrowne.com) is known for its flavorful and intense single-vineyard wines, under its Sonoma Coast and Russian River appellations. The winery was founded by Dan Kosta and Michael Browne who, in 1997, bought a half ton of pinot noir, a used barrel, and an old hand-crank stemmer-crusher to begin their winemaking venture. Since that vintage, they have nurtured relationships with the best growers and honed their winemaking skills, while focusing on the vision and values with which they began.

In 2001, Dan and Michael partnered with Chris Costello and his family, whose business experience has given Kosta Browne the necessary resources to grow. The winery now offers the following, in current release: a 2007 rosé of pinot noir, a 2006 Russian River pinot noir, a 2006 Sonoma Coast pinot noir, and a 2005 Amber Ridge syrah. ●
