Landmark Vineyards



FOUNDED IN SONOMA COUNTY IN 1974 by Damaris Deere Ford, great-great-granddaughter of John Deere, Landmark Vineyards (www.landmarkwine.com) sits upon a lush 20-acre wine estate. The Spanish-mission-style winery is equipped with state-of-the-art winemaking equipment, capable of producing 20,000 cases of wine per year.

Landmark's wines have consistently garnered rave reviews from wine critics, and its signature Overlook Chardonnay has appeared on the Wine Spectator "Top 100" list six times since 1997. Also among Landmark Vineyards' wines are the Grand Detour Pinot Noir and Steel Plow Syrah. In addition to the estate vineyard, Landmark sources grapes from a range of the finest vineyards in California's wine-growing regions.

Landmark also features a beautifully appointed one-bedroom guest cottage, overlooking the vineyard, as well as an elegantly decorated guest suite with a view of Sugarloaf Ridge and Hood Mountain. ●
