NEMACOLIN WOODLANDS RESORT IS PERFECTLY positioned in picturesque Farmington, Pennsylvania and covers 2,000 expansive acres.

The property (www.nemacolin.com) boasts

320 luxurious guest rooms, suites, townhomes, and single-family homes, 124 of which are located in the Chateau LaFayette. Nemacolin offers guests over 100 treatment options at the Woodlands Spa, more than 31,000 square feet of meeting and banquet space and a private airfield, 10 dining venues and seven bars and lounges, and an extensive list of outdoor attractions including two golf courses; a 30-station sporting clays facility; the Adventure Center with a climbing wall, a ropes course, and a 1,060-foot zip line; the 18-mile Jeep® Off-Road Driving Academy; trail rides, and dog sledding; a downhill and cross-country skiing facility; and the large Hawaiian-style Paradise Pool.

Guests seeking the top-of-the-line experience at Chateau Lafayette can request the \$3,000-per-night Presidential Suite where they have access to their own personal, 24-hour-a-day butler to cater to all of their needs. Located on the Club Level, the two-bedroom suite offers one king bed in each bedroom and boasts two full baths with jetted bathtubs, a half bath, sitting area with a fireplace, dining area, and two French balconies. Guests will also appreciate access to a hospitality lounge, complete with breakfast, afternoon tea, and evening cocktails. In addition, the room itself offers an in-room entertainment lounge.

Visitors seeking out a more exclusive experience can stay at Falling Rock, the Forbes Five Star AAA Five Diamond Frank Lloyd Wright-inspired 42-room boutique hotel overlooking the Mystic Rock golf course.

Guests of Falling Rock can request the best the property has to offer by choosing a King or Queen suite, one of only four available, each with a balcony overlooking the Infinity Pool and the 18th green of Mystic Rock.
