Guests will enjoy complimentary beverages upon arrival, Voss water at turndown, and a selection of Bulgari amenities, and most suites offer wood-burning fireplaces, some have terraces, and almost all have fully equipped kitchens.



Guests seeking a first-rate experience at The Lowell may opt for the 900-square-foot Garden Suite. One of four Specialty Suites, which was recently renovated by acclaimed interior designer, Michael Smith, the one-bedroom space offers two terraces – one, a sitting area with a fountain and the other, a cozy dining area. Many of the elements in the space evoke nature, such as the bedroom's floral 18th-century Chinese inspired wallpaper by Oplontis, the kitchen's limestone floor, and the hardwood floors throughout the living area. The suite features a living room with wood-burning fireplace and a library of books, and in-suite amenities include a marble bathroom, full service kitchen, in-room fax, two large flat-screen televisions with movies on demand and VCR, CD, and DVD player, five telephones, complimentary wireless high-speed Internet access, welcome beverage of choice upon arrival, complimentary *New York Times* daily, full size Bulgari bathroom amenities, complimentary shoe shine, complimentary Voss water with nightly turndown service, and complimentary access to the fitness center. ●
