The hotel boasts amenities like complimentary chauffeured transportation to Union Square and the Financial District and access to Nob Hill Spa and the spa's indoor pool, whirlpool, and eucalyptus-infused steam rooms. The Huntington Hotel also features the award-winning Big 4 Restaurant, known for its contemporary American cuisine and classic

cocktails. Visitors looking to host an event or schedule a meeting have access to over 2,000 square feet of flexible space, wireless Internet access in the lobby, and guest and meeting rooms, as well as a business center and full catering service from the Big 4 Restaurant.

The most discerning travelers will revel in the custom-designed Mulholland Suite, which offers distinct pieces from the Mulholland furniture collection throughout its two rooms and bath.

In 2008, Mulholland celebrated their 20-year anniversary with the unveiling of the suite, and the interior design for the rooms was conceived by the luxury leather goods maker to reflect and honor the company's heritage. The upholstery and leather trims are derived from the quality materials of Mulholland's luggage collections, metallic finishes reference the hardware of their bags, and subtle animal prints recall their original designs for field sport gear made in 1988.

Living and dining areas are set in warm gold, cream, and bronze and the spacious bedroom area showcases cool tones of blue and gray inspired by a city in the fog. Original architecture moldings and windows also provide stunning views of the surrounding city.

Mulholland Suite guests receive a special edition leather business card case and a \$200 gift certificate from Mulholland to be used on their Web site or in their San Francisco store. ●
