STANDING AT THE CORNER OF 76TH STREET AND MADISON Avenue, The Carlyle, A Rosewood Hotel, has been an enduring landmark for East Side social life and a sanctuary for guests and locals. Guests of the legendary hotel can choose from an extensive array of suites, including the Classic Suite, the Superior Suite, the Deluxe Suite, the Premier Suite, and the Carlyle Suite. The Carlyle also boasts an array of Specialty Suites to choose from. Created by influential designers such as Cameron Barnett, Alexandra Champalimaud, and Thierry Despont, these suites represent the most unique room category at the hotel.

The Alexandra Champalimaud-decorated Royal Suite, located on the 22nd floor of the property and offering skyline and East River views, is an elaborate two-bedroom suite providing guests with 1,700 square feet of living space with both a king-bedded and twin-bedded bedroom. There is a full kitchen, dining room for six, two marble bathrooms, a double-high ceiling in the raised living room, grand piano, and mantle fireplace. The Royal Suite also boasts original hardwood floors, area rugs, and indulgent fabrics and linens.

Located on the 28th and 29th floors, the Empire Suite is a duplex providing guests with a residential feel. Offering 2,600 square feet of living space, the suite features two king-bedded bedrooms, an office, four-and-a-half bathrooms, walk-in closets, full kitchen, a private art collection, and exceptional views of Central Park and the New York City skyline. Interior designer Thierry Despont was inspired by the tradition of The Carlyle as an urban refuge for stars and world leaders, an oasis which conjures up memories of John F. Kennedy, Jackie Onassis, and Cary Grant.

Top-of-the-line amenities for guests include Kiehl's® toiletries for men and women, slippers and monogrammed terrycloth bathrobes, three phone sets in each room with dataport capability, a private fax machine, iPod® docking station, wireless Internet, individually controlled thermostat, a fully-stocked mini bar, and nightly turndown service.
