SITUATED ON THE UPPER EAST SIDE WITH access to Madison Avenue's upscale boutiques and restaurants, The Surrey (www.thesurrey.com) provides guests with the feel of an elegant residential town house. Built pre-war in beaux arts architectural design, the property offers 190 salons, including 30 suites, an 1,150-squarefoot Penthouse with a 1,000-square-foot wraparound terrace, and a Presidential suite, which offers guests an outstanding 2,200 square feet of luxurious space with a private terrace, formal dining room, fireplace, and baby grand piano.

The property offers an impressive collection of hand-selected contemporary art including Chuck Close, Richard Serra, and Jenny Holzer.

The property is also a proud home to Daniel Boulud's Café Boulud, which earned a star in the *Michelin Guide* and a three-star review by *The New York Times*, and offers a unique twist on exceptional French cuisine. Bar Pleaides is an elegant hotel bar and lounge featuring decor inspired by fashion icon Coco Chanel, and offers an extensive cocktail menu crafted by mixologist Cameron Bogue. Guests eager to relax during their stay can indulge at the intimate Spa at The Surrey offering skin care, body treatments, and massages. The fitness center features state-of-the-art equipment and is open 24 hours a day, for those eager to stay in shape while away.
