COVERING 2,000 EXPANSIVE ACRES, Nemacolin Woodlands Resort is perfectly positioned in picturesque Farmington, Pennsylvania. The property (www.nemacolin.com) boasts 335 luxurious guestrooms, suites, townhomes, and single-family homes, 125 of which are located in the Chateau LaFayette. There are an additional 42 rooms at Falling Rock, the AAA Five-Diamond Frank Lloyd Wright-inspired boutique hotel overlooking the Mystic Rock golf course, catering to guests with a love for the game.

Guests of Falling Rock can take their stay up a notch by requesting the King or Queen suite, one of only four available, each with a balcony overlooking the pool and the 18th green of Mystic Rock. Suites include a spacious living room with a sofa sleeper and gas fireplace, as well as flat-screen televisions where TV sound is piped through both bathrooms, and a Bose stereo system with CD. Those eager to get some work done during their stay will appreciate wireless, high-speed technology that is accessible throughout the guestrooms, as well as in the lobby area.


Guests of Nemacolin who want to take advantage of such peaceful surroundings can cap their stay with a treatment or two at the Woodlands Spa, which offers over 100 treatment options including massage and facials, as well as hydrotherapy and Ayurvedic experiences.

More than 31,000 square feet of meeting and banquet space is available for patrons who are looking to book events or business gatherings, and a private airfield is also conveniently located on site.

The property also boasts 10 dining venues and seven bars and lounges sure to please a wide variety of palates from modern American cuisine at Lautrec, the Forbes Five-Star and AAA Five-Diamond restaurant, to casual American fare with burgers and billiards at the Tavern.

An extensive list of Nemacolin's outdoor attractions guaranteed to excite any visitor include two golf courses, the PGA Tourtested Mystic Rock and the traditional Links Course; a 30-station sporting clays facility; the Adventure Center with a climbing wall, ropes course, and a 1,000-foot zip line; the 18-mile Jeep® Off-Road Driving Academy featuring Jeep Rubicons; trail rides, dog sledding in the fall and winter; a downhill and cross-country skiing facility; and the large Hawaiian-style Paradise Pool.
