


Located on the top floor of the hotel, the Penthouse Suite offers guests the feeling of staying in a sophisticated private residence with ample living and dining areas, full kitchen, and an 1,100-square-foot private wraparound terrace featuring elegant views of Central Park and the Upper East Side. The suite also boasts a gracious seating area fixed around a striking marble fireplace, an elegant dining room table with seating for six, and a modern kitchen outfitted with GE appliances. The
