Nemacolin Woodlands Resort



SPANNING 2,000 ACRES IN BUCOLIC FARMINGTON, PENNSYLVANIA, Nemacolin Woodlands Resort (www.nemacolin.com) is well known for its impressive list of activities suitable for guests of all ages and catering to an array of interests.

The resort boasts 320 luxurious guest rooms, suites, townhomes, and single-family homes, 124 of which are located in the Chateau Lafayette. Guests of the Chateau Lafayette may request the \$3,000-per-night Presidential Suite where they have access to their own personal butler to cater to all of their needs.

Visitors seeking a more exclusive experience can choose Falling Rock, the Forbes Five Star and AAA Five Diamond Frank Lloyd Wright-inspired 42-room boutique hotel. Guests can choose a King or Double suite, one of only four available, each with a dining balcony overlooking the Infinity Pool and the 18th green of Mystic Rock.

At Nemacolin, there is no shortage of quality fare to fit any taste with a range of 10 dining venues and seven bars and lounges, including the Forbes Five Star and AAA Five Diamond Lautrec.

It would be a challenge to find a resort with such an extensive list of activities available onsite year-round including the 30-station sporting clays facility; the 25-mile Jeep® Off-Road Driving Academy; trail rides and dog sledging; and a downhill and cross-country skiing facility. Visitors arriving during warmer months will revel in access to two championship golf courses; the Adventure Center with a climbing wall, ropes course, and a 1,060-foot zip line; and whitewater rafting that is available at nearby Ohiopyle State Park. An ideal option for families is the Wildlife Academy, which is dedicated to providing interactive entertainment and live animal programs with an emphasis on education. The collection of nearly 100 animals includes lions, a leopard, a two-toed sloth, an alligator, and a spur-thighed tortoise, to name a few.

And there is no better indulgence suited to sooth sore muscles after a busy day of activities than a visit to the Woodlands Spa, which offers over 100 treatment options to refresh and rejuvenate. ●
