The opulent 1,500-square-foot one-bedroom Grand Deluxe Suites feature luxurious living and dining areas, decorative fireplaces, modern kitchens with Viking appliances, new flat-screen televisions, and grand bedrooms. These elegant spaces evoke the feel of a luxurious residence and provide the indulgences of a five-star hotel.

The property's 2,250-square-foot Peninsula Suite is decorated in soft greens and the upholstered walls provide a backdrop for framed antique Asian textiles, Chinese blue and white porcelain, and a grand piano.
