Lotte New York Palace (lottenypalace.com), a renowned New York City luxury hotel, underwent a thorough transformation from a historic Madison Avenue gem to Midtown's largest premier modern hotel. The hotel features 909 spacious guestrooms and suites, including 176 exclusive Towers accommodations, which provide the perfect setting for inspired stays in New York City.

Unique dining venues such as Villard, located in the historic Villard Mansion, offer a formal dining room setting and currently serve power breakfast and brunch on the weekends. Inspired by the gracious style of entertaining favored by Henry Villard, Rarities is an intimate, invitation-only salon just steps from the Villard Mansion's beautifully restored brownstone palazzo. A favorite spot for New York City power players to entertain associates and friends in private, Rarities serves rare wines and Champagnes, pre-prohibition bottled spirits, and signature whiskey flights.

Lotte New York Palace's collection of versatile meeting and event spaces is ideal for weddings, corporate events and special occasions. The hotel's famed Villard Mansion, built in 1882, is recognized as a New York City landmark and gracefully blends with a contemporary 55-story tower. The Madison Avenue courtyard provides a dramatic entryway to the hotel's grand lobby.

Overlooking prominent landmark St. Patrick's Cathedral with expansive views, The Deluxe Corner Two-Bedroom Suites in the Palace measure 1,530 square feet, every inch richly appointed in elegant earth tones with luxurious linens and fine furnishings, creating a distinguished yet comfortable ambiance. An oversized living room features a comfortable sitting area with wet bar, sofa, two club chairs and a sizeable desk, as well as a large dining table seating eight guests. The master bedroom is furnished with a king bed and desk,

and has a walk-in closet and an oversized marble bathroom. The connecting bedroom has two double beds with a large marble bathroom, a spacious seating area and a work desk.

The Towers offers discerning travelers even more options to choose from, including the Towers Triplex Suites, The Champagne Suite, and The Jewel Suite by Martin Katz, all at an astounding 5,000 square feet of space.

Each of its modern, three-bedroom Penthouse Triplex Suites spans three floors and has private elevator access, a double-height living room with 18-foot windows, a furnished outdoor terrace, and a second living room with a working fireplace.

The Champagne Suite spans three floors and features a grand two-story marble parlor adorned with a mural by French artists Alex et Marine, a formal dining room seating 10, and a wine cave. A marble staircase leads to a second floor master bedroom suite and guest room, as well as a library/tasting room. On the third floor, a second sitting area has a woodburning fireplace and sweeping rooftop terrace with a custom waterfall spa.

Finally, the Art Deco-inspired Jewel Suite is an extravagant triplex featuring one-of-a-kind details. A two-story crystal chandelier sets the tone, as does a grand piano and mirrored dining room that seats 10. A master bedroom and guest bedroom are joined by luxurious bathrooms, while a terrace-level hideaway features a woodburning fireplace inside and a stone spa and lush green space outdoors. ●
